He serves on the board of CLP Holdings Limited and Sir Elly Kadoorie & Sons Limited, where he oversees a number of Kadoorie family interests in Hong Kong and overseas. He has also been appointed as a member of HSH's Executive and Finance Committees.

Nicholas T J Colfer

Nicholas Colfer, aged 46, has over 23 years' experience of corporate management in the Asia-Pacific region, principally in real estate, manufacturing and distribution. He is a non-executive director of Tai Ping Carpets International Limited, Sir Elly Kadoorie & Sons Limited and serves on several other corporate boards in Hong Kong.
