In 2010, he joined luxury hotel company Rocco Forte Hotels as Group Finance Director.

Mr. Clark has a diverse and rich experience in the international hospitality industry. In his new capacity with HSH, he will be overseeing the Group's corporate finances and will play an integral role in HSH's expansion and development plans.
